

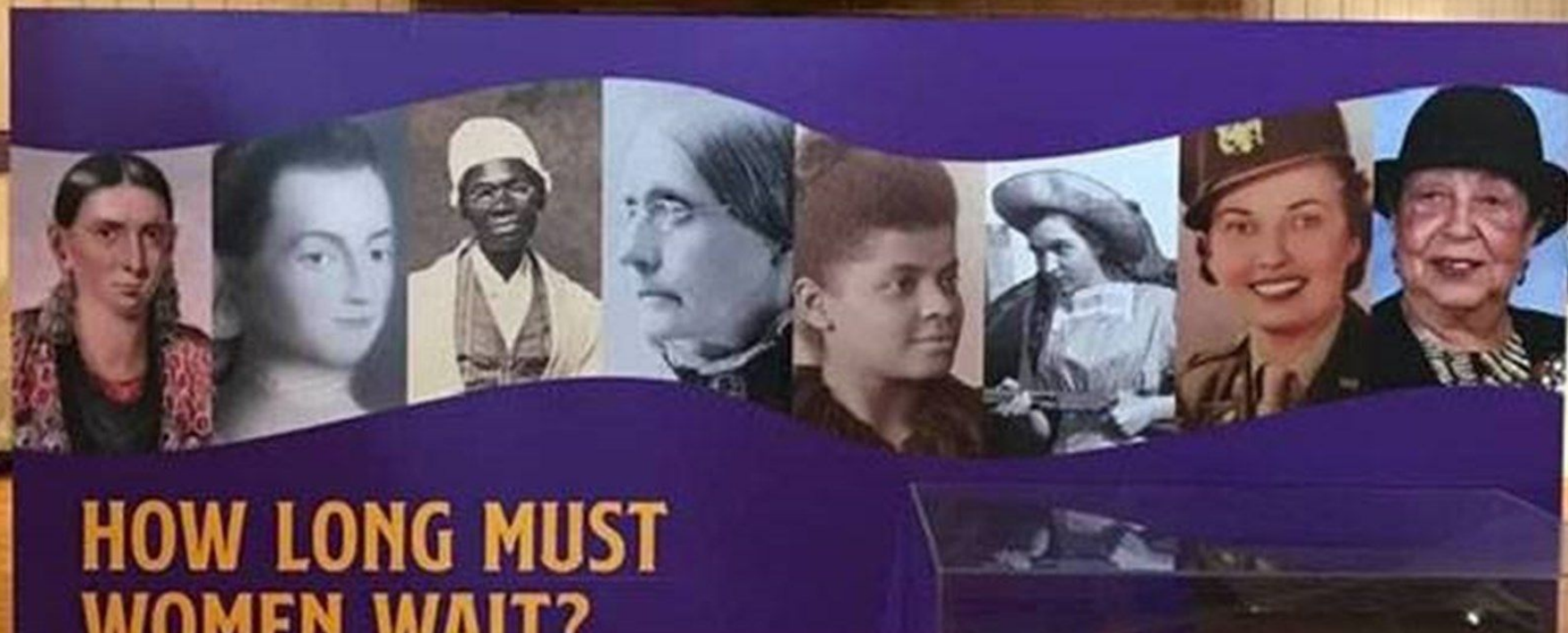
The following examples represent how students in Miami Gardens, FL selected, researched, and then summarized an underreported news story for their classmates.
