-THEY MUST ADHERE TO A STRICT DRESS CODE -ARE BANNED FROM MOST JOBS

- -ARE DENIED SIMPLE PLEASURES SUCH AS VISITING A PARK OR GOING TO A RESTAURANT
- -GIRLS CAN NO LONGER ATTEND SCHOOL BEYOND SIXTH GRADE
- -MUST BE ESCORTED BY A MALE RELATIVE TO TRAVEL WOMEN HAVE BEEN ERASED FROM PUBLIC LIFE


## Al Interpretation of Women's Body Image
