What were the reasons for coming to the U.S?

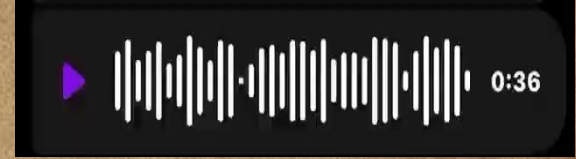


“A few reasons on why they came to the U.S but feels like the biggest one was just better opportunities then Back in Mexico.”

Do you feel like it was the right move for you to come to a new country?

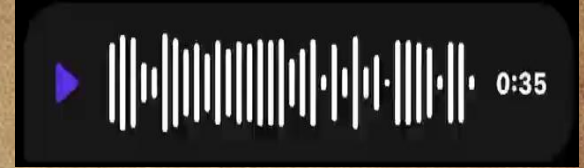
“I was able to get a lot more opportunities here that i'm sure I could've ever had in my home country.”

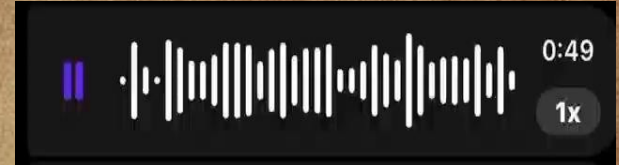
What is your biggest accomplishment in your new country?
