In art next week, after re-reading the first section of the book, *Born on the Water*, students will be making art that tells a story about a time they used their **head, heart, or hands**.

We invite families to talk about the themes of head, heart and hands with your child and related stories they might have. You can ask your child:

**Head** - what is a story you have about using your head/mind?



This could be a time you figured out a hard problem, had a success at school, did something creative, read a great book...

**Heart** - what is a story you have about using your heart?



This could be a time you were kind to a person, an animal or the earth, a time you showed love....

**Hands** - what is a story you have about using your hands?



This could be something you made, drew or built, something you helped with, something you cooked or baked, a baby you held....
