### **Scenarios / Statements**

#### **Climate & Environment**

1. Climate change will affect gig workers more severely than full-time employees.
2. Cities should invest more in shaded public spaces and cooling stations than in new highways.
3. Governments should ban deliveries during dangerous heat waves, even if it reduces consumer convenience.
4. Individual consumer choices (like ordering fewer deliveries during heat waves) make a real difference in protecting workers.

#### **Job Choice & Risk Profiles**

5. Gig delivery jobs give workers more freedom and flexibility, even if they face more risks.
6. Full-time delivery jobs are safer because they usually include benefits like health insurance and paid breaks.

#### **Justice & Policy**
